All employees receive induction training covering or safety policy and ongoing safety education is provided to all employees so that they understand their responsibility of Occupational Health and Safety. Policy changes are distributed by email and verbally as needed.

ATM Tanks investigates all work-related incidents which have or could have resulted in serious injury or ill health and take action to prevent recurrence which includes maintaining a formal incident reporting system.

Each employee is personally responsible for working in a safe manner; following all safety rules and procedures; participating in training; and identifying safety or health issues and reporting those to the management.
